Credential handling

Use one credential set per end customer. Do not place passwords, API keys or sensitive payloads in analytics. Rotate exposed secrets immediately and apply IP or domain allowlists where the integration model permits.

Internal integration	Use inside the customer systems within purchased modules and volumes.	Order and dedicated key
White-label publication	Widget or end-user product publication.	Express permission, territories and branding
Reseller delivery	Feed delivery to a third party.	Reseller addendum and key per end customer
Streaming	Playback depends on event availability and territorial rights.	Event list and provider conditions
External ID mapping	External identifiers only when available and verified.	Source field and fallback rule
